The movie *Field of Dreams* came out in 1989. If you know the movie, you know it was set in Iowa. My boyfriend at the time and I went to see the movie. On our way out of the theater surrounded by other theatergoers, I said to my boyfriend, "That looked like Iowa." It's safe to assume that most if not all of the people who heard me say that thought, "Stupid!" I imagine every single one of them thinking, "*Of course* a movie set in Iowa looks like Iowa!" Do you know exactly where in Iowa the movie was filmed? Dyersville.

I said to my boyfriend, "That looked like Iowa."

My boyfriend said to me, "It was filmed in Dyersville. I thought you knew."

My father grew up on a farm outside of Dyersville. We went to Dyersville every summer of my childhood. I sat through the movie looking at landscape I had seen every year of my childhood. I was looking at my Iowa.

What could anyone get from generously giving me a positive identity? First, I saw more in the movie than every other person at that theater saw. In situations where one person sees more than other people, it is smart to have a connection to the person who sees more. Second, anyone giving me a "stupid" identity was closing off positive identity opportunities for themselves. My father's family was prominent in Dyersville. At one time, my relatives owned the only jewelry store, the only funeral parlor, and the only movie theater. Their prominence gave them connections around northeast Iowa to other prominent people. Anyone wanting a positive identity in northeast Iowa would have been smart to make a connection with me. I had connections who had connections.
